Melvindale firm celebrates 75th anniversary

MELVINDALE — Evans
Distribution Systems hosted a
special celebration last month to
recognize the company's 75th
anniversary and a milestone few
logistics companies in the world
have achieved — 7.5 million
truckloads of goods delivered for
customers.

Evans' associates, customers, local government representatives and Downriver business officials attended a Sept. 9 event that

highlighted the fourth-generation, family-owned company's history in southeastern Michigan supporting the automotive, beverage and chemical industries.

"Our ability to flourish during the past 75 years is a direct result of our associates' hard work and the loyalty of our customers," President John A. Evans said.

"As with previous eras, Evans' business has evolved significantly in recent years to meet the increasingly demanding requirements of global customers.

"We will continue to exceed their expectations as a strategic logistics partner."

Evans Distribution Services, with headquarters in Melvindale, was founded in 1929 as Central Detroit Warehouse Co.

It has evolved into a full-service warehousing, packaging and transportation third-party logistics provider serving the automotive, manufacturing, beverage and chemical industries.

Evans' affiliate companies include Central Detroit Warehouse, Progressive Distribution Centers, Merchants' Forwarding Co., Maverig Freight Inc., Evans Logistics and Alden Logistics.

Several of Evans facilities are ISO 9001:2000 certified. The company employs more than 200 associates, the majority of them located in Michigan. Evans also operates full-service facilities in Suffolk, Va., and Devens, Mass.

This summer, Evans was named one of the country's Top 100 Third-Party Logistics providers of transportation and warehousing services for the second consecutive year by Inbound Logistics magazine, a leading industry publication.

"When my great grandfather, Wellington Evans, started the company 75 years ago, he focused his attention on building close relationships with customers," Chairman John W. Evans. "Obviously, technology has greatly impacted our business and we are working on a global scale now, but this approach to success still rings true.

"A customer's satisfaction is often based in large part on your relationship — the stronger the better."

Evans' success at building such customer relationships is illustrated by the longevity of its key customer relationships.
